About Message Me Emergency Notification System

Under the **Harvard University Emergency Management Plan**, the Harvard community can sign up for SMS/text-message alerts. The **system is activated if there is a life-threatening, campus-wide emergency**, along with other notification systems.

Harvard community members are encouraged to sign up for this text-messaging service to facilitate rapid and effective communication should there be an extreme emergency on campus. A valid Harvard University ID and PIN, or an eCommons ID, is required for access to this service. A mobile phone that is able to receive text messages is required for registration; regular text-messaging charges will apply. The text-message system is tested twice per year. **Registration must be renewed annually.** Users who select this option and provide contact information can be assured information is private and will not be shared.
