

Tip - Disabling and Enabling the Google Pop-Up Blocker

When doing searches on the Internet using the Microsoft Internet Explorer browser, annoying pop-up boxes can be blocked from appearing.

However, when using Harvard Applications such as the various Oracle Financials and Reporting Applications, or TORTE (Telecommunications Online Reporting Tool for End-users), pop-up boxes are necessary.

The Google Toolbar has an Options button to either Disable or Enable the Pop-Up Blocker.



To Disable the Pop-Up Blocker in Internet Explorer:

- Click Options on the Google Toolbar to bring up the Toolbar Options box.
- Click Popup Blocker in the Accessories section to uncheck the box.
- Click Apply button.
- Click OK.

To Enable the Pop-Up Blocker in Internet Explorer:

- Click Options on the Google Toolbar to bring up the Toolbar Options box.
- Click Popup Blocker in the Accessories section to check the box.
- Click Apply button.
- Click OK.
