

Tip - Monitor Power Save Setting

All new Windows XP desktop computers rolled out by DLS have the monitor power setting already set to put the monitor into power save mode “After 20 mins.”

If you'd like to check or change the setting, please follow these steps:

1. Right click on the desktop and select Properties from the pop-up menu.
2. In the Display Properties box, click the Screen Saver tab at the top then click the Power button in the bottom right corner.
3. In the Power Options Properties box, to the right of Turn off monitor, select a time not greater than “After 20 mins” from the pull-down menu.

If you change the power setting, click Apply and then OK in the Power Options Properties box, and click OK in the Display Properties box.

To take a monitor out of Power Save mode, press the spacebar or click the left mouse button. The monitor's power light should change from yellow to green in a second or two so you can see what is on the screen.
